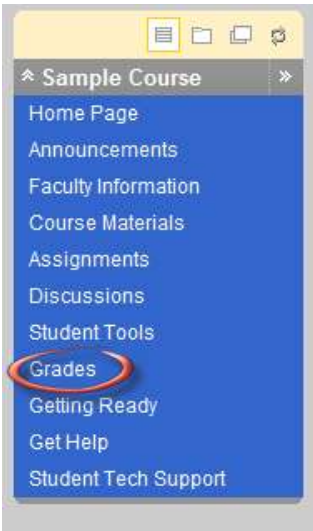


Blackboard Grades Tutorial

To begin, access the course **Grades** area. If available, select **Grades** from the menu, as shown at the left. In some courses, grades located within the **Student Tools** area.



Your Grades Display

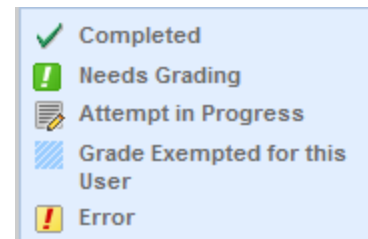
A list of course activities and grades (if available) is displayed.
