

## Blackboard Test Tutorial



Some instructors have a separate course folder or area for quizzes or tests. Other instructors place quizzes or tests directly in each course module or section. The Test Icon, shown at the left, will help you to identify a test or quiz.

### Step 1

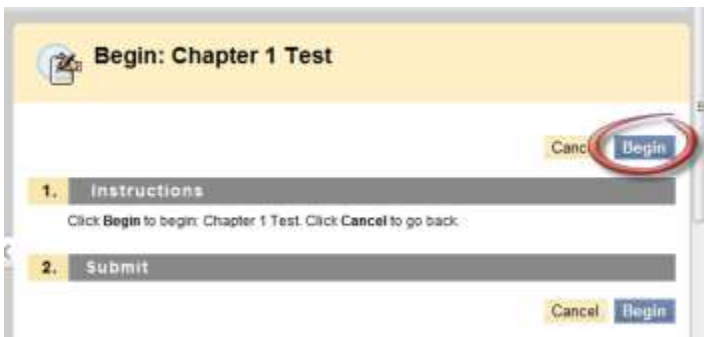


#### Chapter 1 Test

### Step 2



Read the test instructions and click the **Begin** button when you are ready to take the test. Click the **Cancel** button if you have changed your mind and do not want to begin the test.

### Step 3

The test begins. Read the details instructions and information about the test. Your instructor chose the format for the test. Your test might have a time limit and/or might only be available during certain dates. Your test may display the answers all at once or only show them one at a time. Unless you are informed differently, your test will only be able to be taken once. Questions can be in multiple choice, multiple answer, true-false, matching, ordering, fill-in-the-blank, short answer, or essay format. Sample instructions are below:

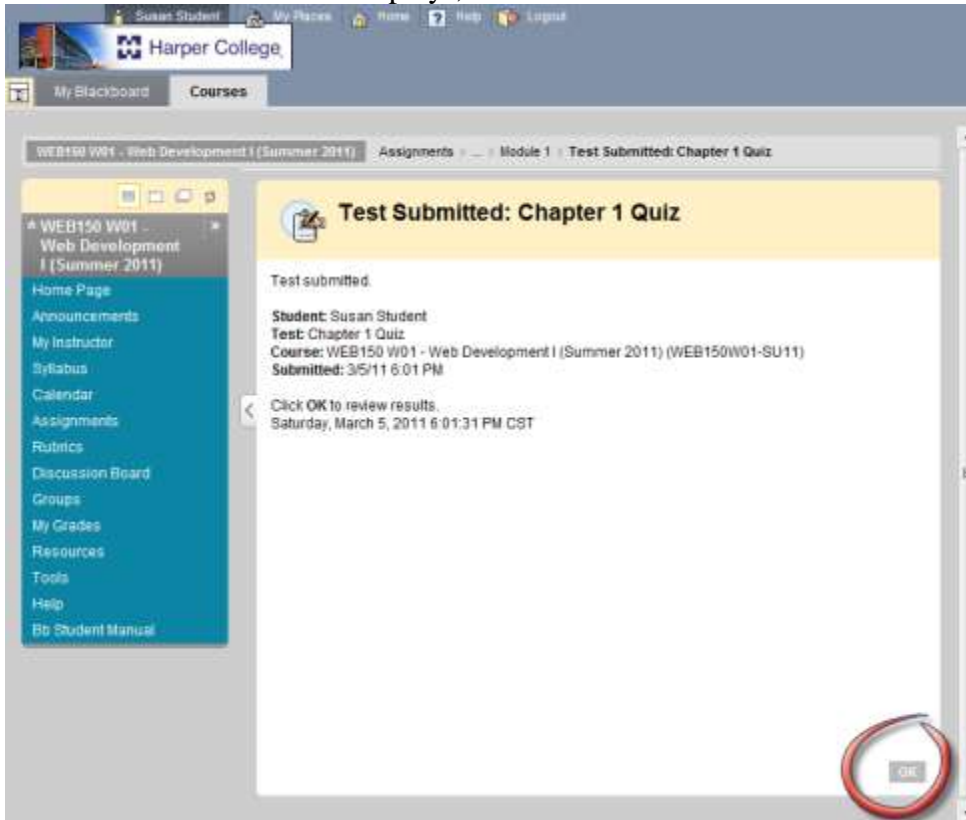
